- a 0943-16 Authorization to execute Agreement with Group CJ LLP in the amount of \$51,500 for mobility office marketing campaign for Fiscal Year 2017. Funds are budgeted. (L0943-16) (Duncan/Paulsen)
- **b** 0977-16 Authorization to proceed through the annual Urban Service Legal Process for 2016. Kentucky Law requires that the Urban County Government notify each property owner by certified mail of a proposed increase in property tax and hold a public hearing. The public hearing will be held at 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 15, 2016, during Council Work Session. There is no budgetary impact. (L0977-16) (Hoskins-Squier)
- c 0980-16 Authorization to amend the Citizen Participation Plan, most recently amended in July of 2007, to include changes in local processes and to reflect new federal regulations. No budgetary impact. (L0980-16) (Gooding/Hamilton)
- d 0989-16 Authorization to execute agreement which allows the continuation of the Drug Enforcement Administration Provisional State & Local Task Force, in which the Lexington Division of Police has two detectives assigned. The term of this agreement shall be from October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017. No budgetary impact. (L0989-16) (Barnard/Bastin)
- е 0990-16 Authorization to execute agreement with the Drug Enforcement (DEA), Tactical Diversion Task Administration Force Agreement. The term of this agreement shall be from October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017. The Tactical Diversion Task Force Agreement allows for one (1) Lexington Division of Police Officer to be assigned to this task force for a period of not less than two years. During this period of assignment, the officer will be under the direct supervision and control of a DEA Supervisory Special Agent assigned to the Task Force. No budgetary impact. - f 0991-16 Authorization to execute a Sole Source Agreement with HACH Company for the purchase of chemical kits required for use of the HACH DR5000 Spectrophotometer in the Division of Water Quality. Quoted fees for services are \$27,554.16. Funds are
