Funds have been requested in the FY2020 budget. (L0355-19) (Allan/Hamilton)
b	<u>0438-19</u>	Authorization to approve a professional services contract with Resource Recycling Systems (RRS) - Material Recovery Facility (MRF) Fiscal year impact \$24,855. Funds are budgeted. Requested \$200,000 in the FY2020 budget. (L0438-19) (Thurman/Albright)
С	<u>0441-19</u>	Authorization to accept deeds of easement and permanent right of way from owners of record for property interests needed for the Bahama Road Stormwater Improvement Project. No budgetary impact. (L0441-19) (Martin/Albright)

Approval of an agreement between LFUCG and Clemson University. Clemson University has sought LFUCG as a preferred internship site for Therapeutic Recreation students. Students are required to complete a 14 week, 560 hour internship (fall, spring and summer options). This agreement will supply needed interns to assist with growing programs for individuals with disabilities while teaching the student necessary skills for job placement in Therapeutic Recreation field. Authorization to submit application to the U.S. Department of Justice requesting federal funds in the amount of \$42,100 under the 2019 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP). No budgetary impact. (L0457-19) (Haney/Armstrong)

Authorization to submit an application to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet--Office of Local Programs and to the Lexington Area Metropolitan Planning Organization requesting federal funds in the amount of \$2,800,000 from the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) for the Euclid Avenue Multi Modal Improvements Project. LFUCG is required to provide a 20% match of \$700,000 which will be requested in the FY 2021 General Fund budget if funding request is approved by KYTC. (L0458-19) (Burton/Albright)

k 0459-19

Authorization to reallocate one (1) classified position of Recreation Assistant from Grade 510N to Grade 514N in the Division of Aging and Disability Services and reallocate the incumbent. Also, abolish one (1) classified position of Community Program Coordinator (Grade 514N) and create one (1) classified position of Recreation Assistant (Grade 514N) in the Division of Aging and Disability Services, reclassifying the incumbent. Both action to be effective the beginning of next pay period following passage of Council. This has a 12-month future impact of a cost of \$6,189.70. (L0459-19) (Maxwell/Hamilton)
