DBA EcoGro for the post-construction monitoring, reporting, and maintenance of the Consent Decree Supplemental Environmental Project completed at Coldstream Park. Fiscal year impact is \$54,312 and a budget amendment is in process. Funds requested in FY20-FY23 for future impact. (L0489-19) (Martin/Albright) 0490-19 Authorization to execute a partial release of a utility easement, j releasing easements at 440 Squires Road. No budgetary impact. (L490-19) (Martin/Albright) Authorization to amend Section 16-48 of the Code to increase 0493-19 k disposal rates for sewage, amending Section 16-59 of the Code to increase fees for sanitary sewer service rates, and amending Section 16-60 of the Code to increase sanitary sewer tap-on fees, effective July 1, 2019 and July 1, 2020.
