- **b** 0538-19 Authorization to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Fayette County Public Schools for transportation services for the 2019-2020 academic school year with the Family Care Center. Funds in the amount of \$78,141.00 were requested in the FY2020 budget. (L0538-19) (Rodes/Ford)

- Authorization to execute an agreement with Welcome House d 0565-19 Northern Kentucky for the operation of the Lexington Payee Program at a cost not to exceed \$483,557.00, with \$156,054.00 in year 1, \$160,595.00 in year 2, and \$166,908.00 in year 3. The Social Security Representative Payment Program (Pavee Program) provides financial management of benefits for people who are incapable of managing their payments on their own. No fiscal year budget impact. Funds were requested in the FY2020 budget. (L0565-19) (Ruddick/Hamilton)

Match in the amount of \$33,723 is required and has been budgeted. (L0590-19) (Theakston/Ford)

- p 0605-19 Authorization for additional funding for the acquisition of easements/right of way and related costs in Zone 2 of the Town Branch Commons project. Increasing the original budget by the sum of \$200,000, amending the authorized amount from \$200,000 to \$400,000. Funds are budgeted. (L0605-19) (Scott)
