Authorization to execute an agreement with Wiser Strategies to provide services to develop stormwater ads and assets, including graphics, images and other components of the ads for one (1) year. There is an option for two (2) renewals, contingent on funding. The amount of the agreement is not to exceed \$50,000.00 per fiscal year. (L889-19) (Plueger/Albright)

Authorization to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet to accept additional federal funds of \$642,296 under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program for the construction phase of the Turn Lane Project at Manchester Street and Forbes Road. Match in the amount of \$160,574 is required. Budget Amendment in progress. (L0891-19) [Burton/Albright]

Authorization to accept the attached agreement with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), Tactical Diversion Squad Task Force Agreement. The term of this agreement shall be from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020. The Tactical Diversion Squad Agreement allows for one (1) Lexington Police Department Officer to be assigned to the Tactical Diversion Squad for a period of not less than two years. During this period of assignment, the officer will be under the direct supervision and control of a DEA Supervisory Special Agent assigned to the Tactical Diversion Squad.
