- a <u>1008-19</u> Authorization to establish Adapt Pharma as a sole source provider of nasal Narcan for the Comprehensive Opiod Abuse Site-Based Program in the Division of Fire and Emergency Services at a cost not to exceed \$64,425. [L1008-19] (Chilton/Armstrong)
- Authorization to amend Section 2-151(a) of the Code of <u>1019-19</u> b Ordinances related to the Keep Lexington Beautiful Commission, changing the name of Bluegrass PRIDE to Bluegrass Greensource, correcting the name of the Department of Environmental Quality and Public Works, deleting two (2) members representing neighborhood associations, and increasing the number of members appointed from the community at large from three (3) members to

five (5) members. No budgetary impact. (L1019-19) (Plueger/Albright)

- c <u>1022-19</u> Authorization to renew a Purchase of Service Agreement with the Children's Advocacy Center of the Bluegrass. As a result of the funding provided by the Lexington Police Department to the Children's Advocacy Center of the Bluegrass, there will be extended hours of operation, they will create additional slots for Police Department forensic interviews.
