- Authorization to submit a grant application, and accept award if offered, requesting an amount up to \$40,000 from the Blue Grass Community Foundation's Support for the Aging Community in Central Kentucky Grant Opportunity to support the Dementia Friendly Lexington Initiative. No matching funds are required. (L1157-19) (Stambaugh/Ford)
- Authorization to approve the rental agreement with the Lexington Center Corporation for the 2020 Martin Luther King Day Celebration in the amount of \$9,000.00. Funds are budgeted. (Scott)
- Authorization to execute a contract between Fayette County Public Schools and the Division of Family Services, for preschool services at the Family Care Center. This contract will provide for the operation of preschool classrooms onsite at the Family Care Center. Fayette County Public Schools is legally required, effective at the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year, to make available free appropriate education and related services to all eligible children with disabilities, and the Family Care Center can provide those preschool services that will fully comply with the state requirements.
