## **Administrative Synopsis - New Business Items**

a <u>1196-19</u>

Authorization to change the base pay of employees in order to conform to the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) and bringing all affected incumbents to the new required salary threshold status, effective the first payroll Monday following passage of Council. Effective January 1, 2020, the "standard salary level" for exempt employees is increasing from \$455 per week (\$23,660 per year) to \$684 per week (\$35,568 per year). In accordance with the U.S. Department of Labor's FLSA regulations and after a review of the incumbents' respective salaries, it has been determined that those employees who are slightly below the required threshold be increased in order to comply with the law. This has a 12-month future impact of a cost of \$3,898.30. (L1196-19) (Maxwell/Hamilton)

Authorization to execute Change Order No. 2 to the agreement with Smith Management Group for the Wastewater Treatment Plants Safety Program Audit and Post Audit Implementation Services Project, increasing the contract price by the sum of \$230,000.00 from \$532,311.25 to \$762,311.25. Authorization to execute a second amendment to the agreement with Bluegrass Care Navigators to expand the Medical Respite Care Program at a cost not to exceed \$11,000 to provide medical respite care for those experiencing homelessness that have been referred for a full colonoscopy procedure. Authorization to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Lexington Housing Authority for the Foster Youth Independence Initiative. This initiative will align the Kentucky Department of Community Based Services, the Lexington Housing Authority, and the Continuum of Care for housing referrals and placement providing services for foster youth at-risk or experiencing homelessness. Authorization to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 3 with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, accepting \$212,000 of additional federal CMAQ funds for the construction phase of the Fourth Street Corridor Enhancement Project. Match of \$2,800 is required. Budget amendment is in process. (L1258-19) (Burton/Albright) Authorization to execute a 5-year Lease Agreement with VertiQ h <u>1261-19</u> Software, LLC, for Hosted Software as a Service (SaaS) for the Coroner's Data Management System, at a cost not to exceed \$18,900 annually. (Nugent/Valicenti) Authorization to submit a grant application, and accept award if i 1262-19 offered, requesting \$10,000 in state funds from the Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services for Fiscal Year 2021. Funds will be budgeted if grant is awarded. (L1262-19) (Chilton/Armstrong) Authorization to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 2 with the j 1263-19 Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, accepting additional federal funds of \$8,000 for the Wilson Downing Sidewalk Project. Match of \$2,000 is required. Budget amendment in process. (L1263-19) (Burton/Albright) Authorization to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) k 1264-19 between the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Department of Veterans Affair Lexington-Fayette and the Urban Government. The MOU states that while the FBI retains primary jurisdiction on this federal property, the Division of Police would be the primary response agency in "emergency tactical situations" due to the close proximity and response time of the response team. o	<u>1271-19</u>	Authorization to execute the acquisition of right of way and easements for the Mercer Road Improvements at Greendale. Budgetary implication of the expenditure of \$258,000.00. Funds are budgeted. (L1271-19) (Burton/Albright)
p	<u>1272-19</u>	Authorization to execute a Subordination Agreement for the loan of federal HOME funds to SRO, Ltd., which subordinates the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's second mortgage securing a principal amount of \$720,000. No budgetary impact. (L1272-19) (Lanter/Hamilton)
q	<u>1273-19</u>	Authorization to execute a 5-year leasing agreement with Dell Financial Services to consolidate and modernize the data center at a cost not to exceed \$215,897.68 annually. No budget impact for this fiscal year. Funds to be budgeted in FY21. (L1273-19) (Nugent/Valicenti)
r	1274-19	Authorization to approve a calendar year General Term Order (GTO) for the Fayette County Sheriff and the Fayette County Clerk. The GTO is an authorization form that summarizes maximum annual expenditures for personnel, operating and capital and is used by the Department of Local Government as a guideline for approval of reimbursement of expenditures. The CY 2020 GTO's need to be approved in order for the expenditures of these offices to be processed by the Department of Local Government.
