# Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request authorization to execute an agreement awarding a Class B (Infrastructure) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant to Fayette County Public Schools (FCPS) for a Feasibility Study improving water quality, at a total cost not to exceed \$35,000.00.

## Purpose of Request

This grant is for a Feasibility Study to evaluate opportunities to implement stormwater Best Management Practices (BMPs) for multiple watersheds in Fayette County. The projects purpose is to improve water quality in the Cane Run, East Hickman, North Elkhorn, South Elkhorn, Town Branch, West Hickman, and Wolf Run watersheds. By assessing outreach opportunities the study is capable of providing stormwater education for over 40,000 Fayette County students.

## Project Cost in FY16 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$35,000.00 and is anticipated to be fully spent by FY17.
