## Request:

Request Council Authorization to submit application requesting grant funding in the amount of \$22,000 from State Farm's Good Neighbor Citizenship Company Grant for providing education on auto/roadway safety, home safety, fire prevention and disaster preparedness for people with language barriers.

## Why are you requesting?

The purpose of the Good Neighbor Citizenship Company Grant is to build safer, stronger and better educated communities across the United States. Funded through State Farm, these grants focus on safety, education and community development. The Division of Multicultural Affairs will use the grant funds to procure professional services and for the purchase of operating supplies for education on auto/roadway safety, home safety, fire prevention and disaster preparedness for people with language barriers.
