## Request:

Request Council authorization to accept award of federal funds in the amount of \$39,200 from the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security for funding of for Urban Search & Rescue (USAR) Technical Search and Rescue Technician Training and Certification for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services under the 2016 State Homeland Security Grant Program.

## Why are you requesting?

On June 23, 2016 (Resolution 400-2016), Council authorized submission of an application to the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security requesting federal funds for a for Urban Search & Rescue (USAR) Technical Search and Rescue Technician Training and Certification Program for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services. The state agency is offering the LFUCG federal funds in the amount of \$39,200.

## What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

\$39,200 in grant funds are being budgeted for Fiscal Year 2017. No matching funds are required. There is no cost in future budget years.
