Request

Authorization to establish Metals Treatment Technologies, LLC MT2) as a Sole Source Vendor for the extraction of lead from the Lexington Police Department's Firing Range berm.

Why are you requesting?

Recommended Sole Source provider is MT2 who would be providing the Lexington Firing Range Facility with lead maintenance services that will support in mitigating potential physical, occupational, and environmental hazards associated with high concentrations of lead in the backstop berms at the range; as well as ensuring compliance with OSHA, US EPA, State, and NRA recommended firing range environmental Best Management Practices (BMPs). The lead maintenance treatment will reduce lead exposure for all agencies that utilize our facility along with reducing the amount of lead leaching into the soil and nearby stream. Recommended project completion date January 2017.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

The total cost of the entire project is projected to not exceed \$42,250
