SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET SUMMARY

All federally-funded CMAQ projects are set up in phases (design, ROW, utilities, construction). No work can begin on any phase of a project until the KYTC Office of Local Program provides a written notice to proceed for that phase. Funding for this project will be programmed with FHWA as each phase is approved. Effective December 26, 2014, FHWA requires a project end date for each federal project phase programmed. As each phase of the project is programmed with FHWA a supplemental agreement will be sent to the project sponsor to add the funding and adjust the project end date. Any expenditures incurred by the project sponsor after the end date will not be eligible for reimbursement. If the project sponsor requires an extension, they must notify the Office of Local Programs thirty (30) days before the project end date.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO. TWO (2) TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET, FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE PERFORMANCE PERIOD THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2019, FOR DESIGN OF PHASES IV, V, AND VI OF THE TOWN BRANCH TRAIL PROJECT, UNDER THE CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) PROGRAM, AT NO COST TO THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO ACCEPT ADDITIONAL FEDERAL FUNDS, FROM THE KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET, WHICH FUNDS ARE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$616,000.00, UNDER THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP), ARE FOR THE FINAL DESIGN OF PHASE VI OF TOWN BRANCH TRAIL PROJECT, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH OBLIGATES THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF \$154,000.00 AS A LOCAL MATCH, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN THE GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute Amendment No. Two (2) to the Agreement, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, for the extension of the performance period through December 31, 2019, for design of Phases IV, V, and VI of the Town Branch Trail Project, under the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program, at no cost to the Urban County Government.

Section 2 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to accept additional Federal funds, from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, which funds are in the amount of \$616,000.00, under the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP), are for the final design of Phase VI of the Town Branch Trail Project, the acceptance of which obligates the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of \$154,000.00 as a local match.

Section 3 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is hereby authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget previously established for this Grant.

Section 4 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
