Request:

Council authorization to execute Amendment to Agreement with GreenHouse17, modifying Article IV, which lists which activities may be completed and the amount to be reimbursed under the Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program.

Purpose of Request:

On April 10, 2014 (Resolution No. 150-2014), Council approved acceptance of federal funds from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women for provision of services under the Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program and approved agreement with Greenhouse17 in the amount of \$67,900 for provision of services.

On October 13, 2016 (Resolution No. 623-2016), Council approved the execution of an amendment to the agreement that extended the Period of Performance through September 30, 2017.

A second amendment is requested which modifies the amounts designated for each activity listed in the agreement under Article IV, "Payment".

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? There is no additional cost in this fiscal year. Costs in in future budget years are dependent upon award of additional federal funds.

Are the funds budgeted? Yes. No budget amendment is needed.
