- 2. The agency complies with applicable state and federal education requirements regarding nondiscrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, disability or age.
- 3. Establishment and maintenance of all preschool records will be in compliance with state and federal regulations that are applicable to financial and programmatic records, supporting documents, statistical and other records. (34 CFR 80.37 8.40).
- 4. The agency will submit reports to the local school district as required in the contract, will make records and visits available to the district to conduct its oversight responsibility, and will make requested information available to the Kentucky Department of Education for the purpose of monitoring state and federal education laws and regulations.
- 5. Personally identifiable information on all children is maintained in a manner consistent with confidentiality requirements of the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
- 6. If the agency receives federal funds, the agency does not appear on the current list of agencies debarred from accepting federal funds.

# **Contracted Services**

- 7. Any agreement and/or contract between the local school district and the agency's preschool program is in writing and has been reviewed and approved by the authorized administrator of each agency.
- 8. Program services provided by a contract or agreement with a local school district are provided in conformance with preschool and school regulations promulgated by the Kentucky Board of Education.
- 9. The agency carries current insurance for the services operated.
- 10. Agency personnel who provide preschool services under an agreement or contract with a local school district meet the personnel requirements of the Kentucky Board of Education and the Education Professional Standards Board.

#### **Operation of the Preschool Education Program**

The Family Care Center provides early childhood services for children ranging in age from six weeks to five years. Fayette County Schools and Family Care Center combine efforts to provide public preschool services serving two groups of children by utilizing double sessions in one classroom. (Session 1: 7:00AM to 9:55AM; Session 2: 10:50AM-1:45PM) Fayette County Public Schools assigns and provides supervision for the lead teacher for the classes as well as a para educator. Child Care services are available for families requiring before and/or after Early Start hours as well as days FCPS Preschool is not in session.

#### **Parent Outreach**

Family Care Center partners with Fayette County Public Schools to provide high school classes for teenage mothers. Mothers that attend the program are eligible for parenting classes, and reading-to-children activities in addition to their classroom studies.

All parents utilizing early childhood services are invited to attend month Big Room events. All classrooms conduct parent/teacher conferences at least twice per year. The FCPS Preschool program conducts Family Story Hour activities in accordance with the FCPS Preschool calendar as well as home visits. Newsletters are sent to parents informing them of activities and upcoming events.

# Related Services by Licensed Professionals for Children with Disabilities

Fayette County Public Schools provides speech therapy, occupational therapy, physical therapy for eligible children. The FCPS therapists work with classroom staff to meet the IEP goals. First Steps referrals are made for children who are not yet three years of age.

# **Transportation**

Transportation is provided by Fayette County Public Schools.

# **Food Services**

The Family Care Center participates in the Kentucky Department of Education Division of Nutrition & Health Services Child & Adult Care Food Program. Children attending full day child care are provided breakfast, lunch and PM snack. Children attending only during FCPS Preschool receive one meal; breakfast or lunch depending on the session. Food is provided by a catering service and meets USDA guidelines.
