SUBJECT: Grant application requesting federal funds under the Juvenile Justice Fiscal

Incentive Program for the Division of Youth Services

## Request:

Request Council authorization to submit an application to the Kentucky Department of Juvenile Justice under the Juvenile Justice Fiscal Incentive Program requesting federal funds in the amount of \$200,000 to operate the Justice Reinvestment Program serving youth referred by the Courts to the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's Department of Youth Services.

## **Purpose of Request:**

The Division of Youth Services has prepared a grant applications for submission to the KY Office of Juvenile Justice requesting \$200,000 under the Juvenile Justice Fiscal Incentive Program. If approved, these funds will be used to operate a program serving youth referred by the Courts to the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's Department of Youth Services. LFUCG will partner with Youth Advocate Programs, Inc. (YAP) who will provide wrap-around services to the youth selected for the program.

## What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

\$200,000 is being requested for FY 2018. No matching funds are required.

## Are the funds budgeted?

Funds will be budgeted if application for funding is approved by the Kentucky Department of Juvenile Justice.
