SUBJECT: LEXINGTON-FAYETTE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE

Request:

Council authorization to execute agreement with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. in the amount of \$88,014 for updating the Lexington-Fayette Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Purpose of Request:

On August 30, 2016, Resolution No. 532-2017, Council approved the acceptance of federal funds from the Kentucky Emergency Management Agency and the FEMA's (Federal Emergency Management Agency) Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the Lexington-Fayette County comprehensive Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Federal regulations require that Hazard Mitigation Plans be updated every five years. The current Hazard Mitigation Plan was adopted by Council in April of 2013. The purpose of this project is to re-evaluate the risk and impacts to the community and to update the plan as identified by this review in order to have an approved revised plan in place by the expiration date of the current plan.

RFP 32-2017 was issued, and Stantec was selected as the consultant to manage the plan process.

Cost in this Budget year and future budget years: The cost is \$88,014. No additional costs are anticipated.
