SUBJECT: Purchase of an approved Urban Search and Rescue Technical Search Course

Request:

Request Council approval for execution of agreement with Spec Rescue International in the amount of \$39,200 for the purpose of conducting an Urban Search and Rescue Technical Search Course in March at the Fire Training Academy. The cost is \$39,200.

Why are you requesting?

On November 3, 2016 (Resolution 665-2016), Council authorized the acceptance of federal funds from the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security for purchase of Urban Search & Rescue (USAR) Technical Search and Rescue Technician Training and Certification Program for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services. RFP #31-2017 was issued for these services. Only one company, Spec Rescue International, responded with a proposal.

What is the Cost in this budget year and future budget years?

The cost is \$39,200. No additional costs are anticipated.
