This agreement is made and entered on <u>January 1, 2018</u>, into by and between LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, an Urban County Government of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, created pursuant to KRS Chapter 67A (hereinafter "Government") and <u>JRC Crew 728</u> the signer, (hereinafter "Organization") with offices located in Lexington, KY.

The Agreement for the Adopt-A-Spot Program follows that:

- 1. Government hereby employees Organization for the period beginning January 1 and continuing for twelve (12) months until expiration of this agreement on December 31. It is understood that award of this contract does not obligate the Government for services with Organization in subsequent years.
- 2. Government shall pay Organization quarterly the sum of \$495.06 for each Adopt-A-Spot cleanup (March, June, September, and completed by December 15) for a total amount of \$1980.24 for the 12 month period.
- 3. Department of Environmental Quality & Public Works (DEQPW) shall provide garbage bags (as needed) for cleanup services.
- 4. Organization agrees to complete and submit quarterly report on or within 48 hours of cleanup. Report shall include cleanup date, volunteer names and hours, number of bags collected and/or other debris that could not feasibly be collected in garbage bags.
- 5. Organization shall perform all duties and services included in the Agreement, if Organization fails to provide litter pickup services by the end of the month, DEQPW reserves the right to hire a third party to perform the monthly cleanup. Failure of the Organization to provide cleanup services in any two months shall result in termination of the Agreement.
- 6. All trash collected by the Organization shall be transported by the Organization to a location mutually agreed to by DEQPW and the Organization, where it will be picked up by a Division of DEQPW on the next working day; or any refuse collection center authorized by the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- 7. DEQPW must approve all proposed changes to this Agreement. The Organization must provide written explanation of any changes. Any statement or promise not contained in this Agreement is not valid or binding.
- 8. Organization agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Lexington-Fayette Urban Count Government from any and all claims or losses of whatever kind that arise from or are alleged to have risen directory or indirectly, in who or in part, from the performance and execution of this Service Agreement.
- The Organization agrees to comply with all applicable local and state rules, ordinances and laws in implementation of the project. The Organization shall prove equal employment opportunity to qualified persons in every aspect of its employment policy and practices.
- 10. Rural Area 14 Includes the following streets, From Buena Vista beginning at Winchester Rd to Elkhorn Rd. From Thunderstick Dr to Wilkes Way and Coriander Ln to Curtiswood Dr. From Call Dr. to Executive Dr. ending at Winchester Rd.
