Change Order #1 - Hydromax USA LLC

## Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request a resolution approving a change order, in the amount of \$7,100, to Hydromax USA for providing two (2) additional temporary sanitary sewer flow monitoring sites for the Division of Water Quality.

## Purpose of Request

This contract was previously approved by Resolution No. 12-2018 in the amount of \$262,050. Since that time, additional monitoring sites have been identified where the data collected during the four month 2018 monitoring period would be beneficial for future Remedial Measures capital project planning. Annual, temporary flow monitoring of the sanitary sewer system is a requirement and essential component of the EPA approved sanitary sewer Capacity Assurance Program (CAP).
