- 2.8 Core Charges: Under the terms of this contract the LFUCG agrees to provide a suitable core for all rebuilt or exchange parts purchased requiring such an exchange. In the interest of paperwork reduction and lower administrative cost, the LFUCG requires that vendors NOT invoice core deposit charges.
