## SUBJECT: Amendment #3 to Senior Citizens Agreement for Fiscal Year 2018

## **Request:**

Request Council Authorization to amend grant agreement with the Bluegrass Area Development District to accept additional federal funding in the amount of \$2,100 for the Senior Citizens Center in FY 2018.

## **Purpose of Request:**

On May 25, 2017, Resolution No. 313-2017, Council approved acceptance of federal funds in the amount of \$109,153 from the Bluegrass Area Development District. Budget amendment #8722 was completed to include an additional \$15,884 in federal funds for the operation of the Lexington Senior Citizens Center in FY 2018. The original grant agreement did not specify the breakdown of eligible reimbursable expenses. On October 26, 2017, Resolution No. 640-2017, Council authorized an amendment to the agreement to incorporate the FY18 budget and breakdown of eligible costs into the agreement. On March 22, 2018, Resolution No. 202-2018, Council authorized an amendment to the agreement to accept \$65,509 in federal funding.

The Bluegrass Area Development District has offered LFUCG an additional \$2,100 in federal funding.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? \$2,100.

Are the funds budgeted? BA 9342 is in process.
