SUBJECT:	Federal funding for Fiscal Year 2018 Chemical Stockpile Emergency

## **Request:**

Council authorization to submit an application and accept award, if offered, to the Kentucky Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management requesting federal funds in the amount of \$1,326,500 under the Fiscal Year 2018 Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP).

## **Purpose of Request:**

The Kentucky Department of Military Affairs, Division of Emergency Management has asked LFUCG to submit an application requesting \$1,326,500 for the continuation of the Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP) for Fiscal Year 2018.

These funds will be used to support salaries and benefits of a part-time administrative assistant, parttime manager, and a public information officer (.5FTE), maintain an alert and notification system, communications, public outreach and education, purchase of supplies, maintenance of equipment and software, EOC enhancements, computer equipment, equipment for traffic control and evacuee support, decontamination equipment, and professional development.

## What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

Preparedness Program (CSEPP)

Available federal funding in Fiscal Year 2019 is \$1,326,500. No matching funds are required. Future years funding is dependent upon availability of federal funding.

Are the funds budgeted? FY19 Budget Amendment is in process.
