SUBJECT: FY19 Kentucky 911 Services Board Award

Request: Council authorization to accept grant from the Kentucky 911 Services Board (previously known as Kentucky Commercial Mobile Radio Services (CMRS) Board) in the amount of \$66,079.89 for the purpose of acquiring hardware, servers, project management, installation services, and shipping to refresh its geo-diverse Solacom 'Host' Controllers for use in E911. Match funds are required in the amount of \$7,342.20.

Why are you requesting? On May 17, 2018 (Resolution 298-2018) Council authorized the submission of an application requesting funding for hardware, servers, project management, installation services, and shipping to refresh its geo-diverse Solacom 'Host' Controllers through its managed services provider: Kraus Associates Inc., d/b/a AK Associates. The Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's (LFUCG) Division of Enhanced 911 is responsible for the Central Kentucky 911 Network (CKy911net), a Category 1 'Host/Remote' provider of 911 selective routing/ANI/ALI controller services and ALI/DBMS services for 911 agencies that have agreements with Lexington. Lexington's goal is to provide a cost-effective host/remote solution to 911 centers. CKy911net is an ESInet, which provides a highly reliable and cost effective point-to-point delivery of 911 calls throughout the state.

Refreshing the Solacom Controller hardware is needed to ensure up-time and reliable delivery of 911 calls to and between participating counties throughout the state.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? State funds are in the amount of \$66,079.89 for Fiscal Year 2019. Match in the amount of \$7,342.20 is budgeted under 4204-505602-0001-78201.

Are the funds budgeted: BA 9443 is in process.
