Request

Request for authorization to enter into an Assistance Agreement by and between Kentucky Infrastructure Authority and the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for a low-interest (1.75%) loan related to the Town Branch Commons/Midland Avenue Trunk Sewer Replacement Project (A17-005).

Purpose of Request

To recommend a favorable funding mechanism for completion of this Consent Decree required capital project. A loan amount of \$9,969,585, would be authorized by an executed Assistance Agreement. The Sanitary Sewer Fund (Fund 4002) and the Water Quality Management Fund (Fund 4051) are the recommended sources of funding for debt service of the loan.
