SUBJECT: Grant Award from the Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services

Request:

Council Authorization to accept award in the amount of \$10,000 in state funds from the Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services for the Division Fire and Emergency Services for Fiscal Year 2019.

Why are you requesting?

On January 30, 2018 (Resolution 42-2018), the Division of Fire and Emergency Services received approval to submit a grant application requesting funding from the Kentucky Board of Emergency Medical Services (KBEMS) in the amount of \$10,000 for Fiscal Year 2019. Funding was approved by KBEMS. Funds will be used for the purchase of Advanced Multipurpose Airway Manikins for the training of EMT and Paramedic personnel within the division. This equipment will be used to teach airway procedures in the EMT and Paramedic Classes, as well as continuing education to line personnel that are already certified within the division.

These are state funds pursuant to KRS 311A.155. No matching funds are required.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

\$10,000 in state funds has been approved for Fiscal Year 2019. There are no anticipated costs in future years.

Are the funds budgeted: BA 9505 is in process.
