## Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY19 (Class A) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for The Woodfield Homes Association, Inc. in the amount of \$48,000.00.

# Purpose of Request

The overall goal of this project is to provide water quality and quantity control by restoring the stormwater pond through filtering out nutrients and reducing sedimentation from pond bank erosion. The project elements include the design and construction of a new outlet valve structure, stabilizing the remaining eroding/slipping pond banks with rock toe and stable slope, installing a vegetated littoral shelf, and reestablishing a "no-mow" riparian zone along the pond's edge. The Woodfield Homes Association will also host a public involvement field day and install an educational sign.

## Project Cost in FY19 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$48,000.00.
