**Request:** Council authorization to execute FY19 Neighborhood Action Match Program contracts with the following: Andover Neighborhood Association (\$10,000), Griffin Gate Community Association (\$10,000), Harrods Hill Recreation Center (\$10,000), Palomar Hills Community Association (\$3,235), Still Meadow Homeowners Association (\$10,000), Village at Tatescreek Homeowners Association (\$10,000), and Walnut Creek Homeowners Association (\$4,302).

## Why are you requesting?

Grants and Special Programs received 30 applications requesting funds under the Fiscal Year 2019 Neighborhood Action Match Program. The Neighborhood Action Match Program Review Board met and reviewed requests for funding. Those projects listed above have been recommended for funding.
