SUBJECT: Bid #117-2018 Body Scanner for Community Corrections

Bids for the purchase of a body scanner for the Division of Community Corrections were received in the Division of Central Purchasing on September 25, 2018.

IonWave notified three hundred sixty-eight (368) vendors with thirteen (13) vendors viewing the document. Three (3) bids were received.

The low bid was from AT Security for \$85,825 but failed to meet specifications for the following reasons:

- The specifications stated that the “system shall NOT have a conveyor belt” and AT Security’s system has a conveyor belt.
- The specifications stated that the “Platform Capacity should be no less than 600 lbs. and AT Security’s platform has a maximum capacity of only 450 lbs.
- AT Security’s system requires a higher dosage of radiation to accomplish dual view than Romaine Companies limiting the number of times an individual could be scanned.

The second lowest bid was from OD Security North America for \$137,500 but failed to meet specifications for the following reasons:

- OD Security does not offer a genuine DUAL VIEW body scanner due to utilizing one generator, therefore only offering one view. OD is considering a zoomed image of the one image as dual view.



Romaine Companies was the highest bid for \$185,000 but meets all specifications and will meet the needs of Community Corrections.

The bid from Romaine Companies met bid specifications and is within budgetary constraints, therefore, the bid from Romaine Companies is recommended.
