TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT

This TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT is made and entered into this the Louise day of Pournour, 2018, by and between LOUISE M. McGILL, a single person, 3409 Brunswick Road, Lexington, Kentucky 40503, which is the in-care of tax mailing address for the current year ("Grantor"), and LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, 200 East Main Street, Lexington, Kentucky 40507, ("Grantee").

WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of the sum of ONE HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR DOLLARS AND 00 CENTS (\$194.00), and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, said Grantor has BARGAINED and SOLD and does hereby GIVE, GRANT and CONVEY unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, temporary right to excavate, grade, install, construct, alter, inspect, maintain, re-grade and perform related work for the purpose of construction, improvement, and replacement of a sanitary sewer line and other related improvements and appurtenances through and across the following tract of land located in the confines of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, depicted on Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Temporary Construction Easement (a portion of 3409 Brunswick Road) Brunswick Road Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project

Commencing at the Point of Commencement, said point being the northeast corner of Lot 3, as shown on the Plat of

McGill and William & Julie Sabourin; thence with the property line, South 22 Degrees 59 Minutes 43 Seconds West 5.06 feet (L2) to a point; thence leaving the property line, South 67 Degrees 00 Minutes 17 Seconds East 115.15 feet (L3) to a point, said point being on the west right-of-way of Winthrop Drive; thence with the right-of-way line of Winthrop Drive, North 22 Degrees 59 Minutes 43 Seconds East 5.06 feet (L4) to the True Point of Beginning; and,

The above described parcel contains 582.31 sq. ft. or 0.013 Acres of temporary construction easement; and

Being a portion of the property conveyed to Ronnie W. McGill and Louise M. McGill, husband and wife, by deed dated January 12, 1979, of record in Deed Book 1218, Page 29, in the Fayette County Clerk's Office. Said Ronnie Webb McGill died intestate a resident of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky on May 25, 2012. The property vests to his wife, Louise M. McGill, by right-of-survivorship in the aforementioned deed.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said easement together with all rights, appurtenances, and improvements thereunto belonging unto said Grantee, its successors and assigns, for the purposes and uses herein designated.

The above-described temporary construction easement runs with the land for the duration of the improvement project and is binding upon the successors and assigns of the Grantor. The temporary construction easement shall take effect upon the commencement of construction of the project and will expire upon the completion of the project.

Grantor does hereby release and relinquish unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, all of her right, title, and interest in and to the property to the extent of the interest conveyed herein, including all exemptions allowed by law, and does hereby covenant to and with the Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, that she is lawfully seized in fee simple of said property and has good right to sell and convey the same as herein done, and that she will **WARRANT GENERALLY** said title.

The obtaining of this easement was authorized by Resolution 498-2018, passed by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Council on August 30, 2018. Pursuant to KRS 382.135(2)(a), this public utility easement is exempt from the requirements related to certificate of consideration. This conveyance is exempt from real estate transfer tax pursuant to KRS 142.050.


