SUBJECT: 2017 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program

Request: Council authorization to accept award from the U.S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$30,869 under the 2017 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP).

Reasons for Requesting:

On March 22, 2018 (Resolution No. 162-2018), Council approved submission of application to the Bureau of Justice Assistance, a part of the Office of Justice Programs in the U.S. Department of Justice in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, requesting federal funds under the 2017 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP). The U.S. Department of Justice has offered the LFUCG an award in the amount of \$30,869. No matching funds are required.

SCAAP provides funds to States and localities as reimbursement for costs of incarcerated undocumented criminal aliens who have been incarcerated for at least four consecutive days during the reporting period (July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016), and incarcerated on conviction of at least one felony or two (2) misdemeanors. The Division of Community Corrections proposes to use the funding for operating supplies for inmate reentry.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? Are the funds budgeted?

\$30,869 has been awarded for Fiscal Year 2018. There is no cost in future years.
