Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY19 (Class B Infrastructure) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for Northyard, LLC (at 109 W. Loudon Ave.) in the amount of \$24,912.80.

Purpose of Request

The objective of this project is to conduct a feasibility study to evaluate a series of land use alternatives focusing on stormwater management and water quality improvements at 109 W. Loudon Avenue (a 2.5 – acre site). The project expands upon previous work completed in the 2012 "NoLi Sustainability Plan". The project also incorporates an educational element that includes an Urban Infill BMP Pattern Book, workshops, and a design seminar.

Project Cost in FY19 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$24,912.80 and will be fully spent by FY21.
