RE: iconectiv Enhanced Law Enforcement Platform (ELEP) Service Agreement & Sole Source Approval

Request:

The Division of Enhanced 911 is requesting authorization for the Mayor to sign an agreement with Telcordia Technologies Inc. d/b/a iconectiv, which allows this agency to access the Number Portability Administration Center covering the Regional Bell Operating Companies US Service Areas for the purpose of determining which telephone company a phone number is affiliated with. Iconectiv maintains the ELEP "clearing house" telephone portability service for the Federal Communications Commission under an exclusive agreement. Iconectiv data is used to maintain the accuracy of the local 911 database, which identifies the carrier and location (landline) associated with a telephone number used to dial 911.

Why are you requesting?

E911 receives >470,000 calls annually, of which >217,000 are 911 calls. Portability laws allow customers to keep their landline, wireless and VoIP telephone number when changing carriers and/or location, but location and carrier information is occasionally missing from the call data presented to 911. Iconectiv maintains the only database of phone numbers and corresponding carriers.

What are the costs in this budget year and future budget years?

The annual fee is \$6,000.00

Are the funds budgeted?

Yes and fully funded in accounts: 4205-505602-0001-77802 @ \$1,920 + 4204-505602-0001-77802 @ \$80 + 4204-505603-0001-71299 @ \$4,000 .
