That for and in consideration of the sum of ONE HUNDRED SIXTY AND 00/100 (\$160.00), and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, said Grantor has BARGAINED and SOLD and does hereby GIVE, GRANT and CONVEY unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, temporary right to excavate, grade, construct, alter, re-grade and perform related work for the purpose of sanitary sewer improvements and construction, installation and relocation through and across the following tract of land located in the confines of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, depicted on the attached Exhibit "A", and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point 117.69 feet from the owners' Southeast property corner of Lot 33 of Southeastern Hills Subdivision as depicted in Plat Cabinet C, Slide 354 of the Fayette County Clerk's Records; thence with said southern property line North 61 Degrees 29 Minutes 43 Seconds West a distance of 7.50 feet; thence with a new severance line North 28 Degrees 29 Minutes 15 Seconds East a distance of 61.93 feet to a point on the northern property line of the state parcel; thence with that line South 61 Degrees 20 Minutes 49 Seconds East a distance of 7.50 feet; thence with a new severance line South 28 Degrees 29 Minutes 15 Seconds West a distance of 61.92 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

The above described parcel contains 0.011 acres of temporary construction easement;

Being a portion of the property conveyed to James A. Hurt, Sr. and Freda M. Hurt, husband and wife, by deed dated December 6, 2000, of record in Deed Book 2175, Page 478, in the Fayette County Clerk's Office. Said Freda M. Hurt died intestate a resident of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky on January 13, 2019. The property is vested to her husband, James A. Hurt, Sr., by right-of-survivorship.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said easement together with all rights, appurtenances, and improvements thereunto belonging unto said Grantee, its successors and assigns, for the purposes and uses herein designated.

The above-described temporary construction easement runs with the land for the duration of the improvement project and is binding upon the successors and assigns of

the Grantor. The temporary construction easement shall take effect upon the

commencement of construction of the project and will expire upon completion of the

project.

Grantor does hereby release and relinquish unto the Grantee, its successors and

assigns forever, all of their right, title, and interest in and to the property to the extent of

the interest conveyed herein, including all exemptions allowed by law, and does hereby

covenant to and with the Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, that he is

lawfully seized in fee simple of said property and has good right to sell and convey the

same as herein done, and that he will WARRANT GENERALLY said title.

The obtaining of this easement was authorized by Resolution 640-2018, passed

by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Council on October 25, 2018. Pursuant to KRS

382.135(2)(a), this temporary construction easement, which pertains to a public utility,

need not contain a statement of consideration.



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
