Why are you requesting?

This agreement allows Division employees to use the McKinney Driving Track at the Department of Criminal Justice Training (DOCJT) in Richmond, Kentucky for the purpose of advanced emergency driving training. The Division agrees to take certain safety steps to ensure the proper use of the driver track and also agrees to accept any risks associated with the use of the track.
