WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of the sum of THIRTY-EIGHT AND 29/100 DOLLARS (\$38.29), and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, said Grantors have BARGAINED and SOLD and do hereby GIVE, GRANT and CONVEY unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, permanent right to excavate, grade, construct, alter, re-grade and perform related work for the purpose of sanitary sewer improvements and construction, installation and relocation through and across the following tract of land located in the confines of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, depicted on the attached Exhibit "A", and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

The above described parcel contains 642.28 square feet of permanent easement; and

Included in the above described proposed permanent sanitary sewer easement area description is an existing sanitary sewer easement of 255.07 square feet, resulting in a net increase of 387.21 square feet of new easement area; and,

FURTHER, for and in consideration of the sum hereinbefore mentioned, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Grantors have BARGAINED and SOLD and do hereby GIVE, GRANT and CONVEY unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, temporary right to excavate, grade, construct, alter, re-grade and perform related work for the purpose of sanitary sewer placement and construction, installation and relocation through and across the following tract of land located in the confines of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, depicted on Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and more particularly described as follows:

Temporary Construction Access Easement Lansdowne South Trunk Sewer Replacement Project (a portion of 3587 Laredo Drive)

One tract or parcel of land being a temporary construction assess easement situated west of Laredo Drive in Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky and being more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the southwest corner of the property and being a common corner to 3589 Laredo Drive property (Deed Book 3559, Page 93) Gatewood Subdivision. Lot 8: thence N 78°23'27" E, 26.24 feet, more or less along the common property line with the 3589 Laredo Drive property; thence N 12°13'39" W. 8.11, more or less along the western boundary of PROPOSED PERMANENT SANITARY SEWER EASEMENT to THE POINT OF BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION PROPOSED TEMPORARY ACCESS EASEMENT; thence N 33°37'09" W, a distance of 12.85 feet; thence N 78°22'47" E, a distance of 4.69 feet; thence S 12°13'39" E, a distance of 11.92 feet, more or less to THE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THE PROPOSED TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION ACCESS EASEMENT: and,

The above described parcel contains 27.94 square feet of temporary construction easement;

Being a portion of the property conveyed to Gregory White and Nathleen White, husband and wife, by deed dated November 27, 2017, of record in Deed Book 3543, Page 483, in the Fayette County Clerk's Office.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above-described easements together with all rights, appurtenances, and improvements thereunto belonging unto Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, for the purposes and uses herein designated.

The above-described temporary construction easement runs with the land for the duration of the improvement project and is binding upon the successors and assigns of the Grantors. The above-described permanent easement runs with the land in

perpetuity and is binding upon the successors and assigns of the Grantors. The temporary construction easement shall take effect upon the commencement of construction of the project and will expire upon completion of the project.

Grantors shall have the full right to use the surface of the land lying over said permanent easement for any purpose desired, provided such use will not interfere with the Grantee's free use of the easement herein granted and provided further that no building or structure shall be erected upon, across, over or through said permanent easement without prior written consent of the Grantee.

Grantors do hereby release and relinquish unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, all of their right, title, and interest in and to the property to the extent of the interests conveyed herein, including all exemptions allowed by law, and do hereby covenant to and with the Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of said property and have good right to sell and convey the easements as herein done, and that they will **WARRANT GENERALLY** said title.

The obtaining of this easement was authorized by Resolution 58-2019, passed by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Council on February 7, 2019. Pursuant to KRS 382.135(2)(a), this deed of easement, which pertains to a public utility, need not contain a statement of consideration.


