Request

This memorandum is to request award of contracts to six (6) firms for Stormwater Engineering Services under RFP #21-2019.

Purpose of Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of agreements between LFUCG and six (6) engineering firms deemed prequalified to provide engineering services for stormwater management projects—RFP #21-2019.

RFP 21-2019 projects involve stormwater management projects only. The 6 recommended firms are:

2	Banks Engineering, Inc.	5	Strand Associates, Inc.
3	Howard K. Bell Consulting Engineers, Inc.	6	Stantec Consulting Services Inc.



A workgroup consisting of representatives as defined by CAO Policy # 1 recommends selection of these 6 firms. Selection of the firms was based on the criteria provided in the table below.
