WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Grantors own (i) certain real property situated at 195 South Forbes Road (f/k/a 190 South Forbes Road) and 1295 Manchester Street (f/k/a 1289-1295 Old Frankfort Pike) by virtue of deed recorded with the Fayette County Clerk in Deed Book 1299, Page 485, (ii) certain real property situated at 1287 Manchester Street by virtue of deed recorded with the Fayette County Clerk in Deed Book 1112, Page 132, and (iii) certain real property situated at 1281 Manchester Street by virtue of deed recorded with the Fayette County Clerk in Deed Book 1598, Page 17, all located in Lexington, Kentucky; and,

WHEREAS, the Grantee requires portions of the identified parcels for the public purpose of constructing and maintaining Town Branch Trail; and,

WHEREAS, the Grantors are in favor of completion of the Town Branch Trail project and do not wish to delay completion of the project; and,

WHEREAS, the only dispute remaining between the Parties is the value of the property required for construction of the trail; and,

WHEREAS, time is of the essence.

It is the specific intention of the grantor(s) herein to convey a temporary construction easement for the purpose of slope construction; said easement will terminate and revert upon completion of the same.

This Right of Entry shall stay in effect until completion of the project upon the subject property, during which time Grantors and Grantee shall continue to negotiate in good faith the purchase price of the identified parcels. Should the parties prove unable to reach an agreement concerning the value of the parcels during that time, Grantee shall initiate condemnation proceedings in Fayette Circuit Court in accordance with Section 416.540, et seq., of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, where the Court will be asked to settle the parties' dispute, limited to determination of the value of the property. Upon the Court's determination of the fair market value of the required parcels and Grantee's payment of such sum, Grantors shall transfer the parcels described herein to Grantee by General Warranty deed without delay.

Grantee, in the exercise of its rights granted herein, shall ensure that neither it nor its contractors or agents takes any action that would permanently impair or remove the Grantor's existing point of ingress and egress between the parcel located at 1287 Manchester Street and the public right of way known as Manchester Street. Grantee further agrees, in consideration of the rights and privileges granted herein, that it shall construct and install a new point of ingress and egress between the parcel located at 1281 Manchester Street and the public right of way known as Manchester Street.

This Right of Entry is binding upon and inures to the benefit of the parties and their respective successors and assigns, including without limitation any party that may purchase any part of the subject parcels prior to conveyance of the parcels to Grantee as described herein. Grantors shall promptly provide any potential purchaser of the property

with a copy of this Right of Entry and shall notify the potential purchaser that all duties and obligations owed by Grantors hereunder shall transfer to the purchaser immediately upon purchase of the property.
