A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE A MODIFICATION TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE KENTUCKY DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, EXTENDING THE PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2020, UNDER THE CHEMICAL STOCKPILE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PROGRAM (CSEPP) FOR FY 2016.
