SUBJECT: Lexington Area MPO ITS Architecture Update

Request: Council authorization to accept a proposal from AECOM to update ITS architecture at a cost not to exceed \$75,000.

Purpose of the Request: On June 20, 2019 (Resolution 307-2019), Council authorized the acceptance of federal funds for the ITS/CMS (Intelligent Transportation System/Congestion Management System) Traffic Improvements Project for FY 2020. In order to comply with federal ITS standards, the Lexington Area MPO is required to update the ITS architecture a minimum of every five years. The last update occurred in spring 2015 and, therefore, an update is necessary by spring 2020. This update will provide guidance for regional stakeholders to implement existing and emerging ITS technologies.

The Division of Traffic Engineering issued RFP 36-2019 and received two responses. The review committee has recommended AECOM to perform the work at a cost of \$75,000. Funds are budgeted.

The cost in this budget year and future budget years: Total cost for this FY is \$75,000. No costs are anticipated for future budget years.
