SUBJECT: Award of Engineering Services for Jacobson Park Roadway Widening

Request: Council authorization to accept a proposal from Bell Engineering to provide engineering services for Jacobson Park Roadway Widening at a cost not to exceed \$44,150.

Purpose of the Request: On June 21, 2018 (Resolution 400-2018), Council authorized the acceptance of \$1,326,500 in federal funds under the Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP) for FY 2018. Within that budget were funds approved for engineering design work to widen the road over the causeway at Jacobson Park.

The Division of Emergency Management issued RFP 42-2019 and received 4 responses. The review committee has recommended Bell Engineering to perform the work at a cost of \$44,150. Funds are budgeted.

The cost in this budget year and future budget years: Total cost for this FY is \$44,150. No costs are anticipated for future budget years.
