A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE KENTUCKY BOARD OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, TO PROVIDE ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUESTED IN CONNECTION WITH THIS GRANT APPLICATION, AND TO ACCEPT THIS GRANT IF THE APPLICATION IS APPROVED, WHICH GRANT FUNDS ARE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000.00 COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY FUNDS, AND ARE FOR THE PURCHASE OF EMS TRAINING EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING FOR EMT AND PARAMEDIC PERSONNEL FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES, THE ACCEPTANCE OF WHICH DOES NOT OBLIGATE THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TRANSFER UNENCUMBERED FUNDS WITHIN THE GRANT BUDGET.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN

Government, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute and submit the Grant

Section 1 - That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County

Application, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, to the Kentucky

Board of Emergency Medical Services and to provide any additional information requested

in connection with this Grant Application, and to accept this Grant if the application is

approved, which Grant funds are in the amount of \$10,000.00 Commonwealth of Kentucky

funds, are for the purchase of EMS training equipment and training for EMT and Paramedic

personnel for the Division of Fire and Emergency Services, the acceptance of which does

not obligate the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the expenditure of funds.

Section 2 - That subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 22-79, the Mayor is

hereby authorized, in his discretion as Chief Executive Officer of the Urban County

Government, to transfer the unencumbered balance of any operating or capital account

appropriation to another operating or capital account appropriation within the Grant budget

previously established for this Grant.
