SUBJECT: Amendment to RCO 17-2 through 17-4 Addressing Ordinances

## Request:

An ordinance amending Sections 17-2, 17-3, and 17-4 of the Code of Ordinances of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, relating to numbering property; addressing; renumbering; and maintenance of number displays.

Why are you requesting?

The changes are primarily administrative and identify the Division of Enhanced 911/Addressing Office, as the division and office within the Department of Public Safety, responsible for assigning property numbers and street names in Fayette County. Additional changes include, but are not limited to: Eliminates the ability to have two street types appear in a street name (e.g., Avenue of Winners Street); directs the Addressing Committee to reassess street sections not connected after five years to determine if one section needs to be renamed; and authorize commercial address numbers less than 10" in height when appropriate for the circumstances.
