AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 6-8(I) OF THE LAND SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS TO REQUIRE DEVELOPERS TO INSTALL A PERMANENT SIGN DENOTING "END OF PUBLIC MAINTENANCE" AT EACH LOCATION WHERE A PRIVATE STREET INTERSECTS OR OTHERWISE ABUTS A PUBLIC STREET. (URBAN COUNTY COUNCIL).

WHEREAS, the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Planning Commission has considered a text amendment to create Article 6-8(I)(5) of the Land Subdivision Regulations to require developers to install a permanent sign denoting "End of Public Maintenance" at each location where a private street intersects or otherwise abuts a public street. Such sign shall conform to design and material standards prescribed by the Division of Traffic Engineering.
