SUBJECT:

Domestic Violence Prevention Program Amendments to Code of Ordinances

Request:

Request Council Authorization to amend the Domestic Violence Prevention Board Ordinance, to reflect the new name of the Board to the *Domestic and Sexual Violence Prevention Coalition*, to change outdated terminology, and to expand the voting member composition by 3 Ex - Officio members, and 3 At - Large members.

Purpose:

The Board's focus areas have expanded since its establishment in 1986, as reflected in the recently amended mission statement: To create a culture of safety and empowered stakeholders through advocacy, education, collaboration, and service coordination for communities impacted by interpersonal violence.

Also, the expansion of the Ex – Officio and At – Large voting membership is designed to allow for more diverse representation. Currently, the Board has 24 Ex – Officio members, representing LFUCG; local criminal justice officials; victim service providers; Fayette County Public Schools; and Kentucky Cabinet for Health & Family Services. In addition, 7 At – Large members are appointed by the Mayor, and confirmed by Urban County Council.
