Change Order #1 to Contract 565-2018 Renovation of existing Truck Wash Facility

Request

The Department of Environmental Quality & Public Works request approval of Change Order #1 in the amount of \$4,449.00 to Contract 565-2018 with FuelBand Contracting for the Renovation of the existing Truck Wash Facility for the Division of Waste Management.

Reason for Request

The LFUCG on September 27, 2018, entered into a contract with FuelBand Contracting for the Renovation of the existing Truck Wash Facility for the Division of Waste Management located on Byrd Thurman Drive at a cost of \$468,888.00. Since that time, it has become necessary to make changes to the plans for the project.

The changes include:

- 1) Run power to power block for camera/surveillance system, installing conduit to two additional surveillance cameras.
- Install brush sweeps on four overhead doors to prevent birds from entering the building.
- 3) Install 2 additional pressure washer reels/hoses, and wands. This will allow for the use of the existing catwalk.
- 4) Repair multiple leaks in the sprinkler that were found when the system was pressurized.
- 5) Replace 36" entry door on the automated truck wash side of the building with a door that swings outward.
- 6) Install 30" entry door on the pressure washer side of the building to allow for entry without having to use the overhead door



7) Relocate the pressure washer unit to the opposite building wall to allow for easier installation and maintenance.

The cost of these changes are \$4,449.00 and brings the project total to \$473,337.00. This total is still less than the base bid of the next higher bidder.
