New Economic Development Funding Process

- Create a new funding process for economic development
- Change to a two-year cycle similar to LFUCG Workforce Grant Program and ESR Program allowing LFUCG to adjust to economic circumstances and trends
- Allow administration and council to be more active in establishing the economic development goals and priorities for the two year cycle
- Engage Economic Development Investment Board in the overall economic development funding efforts
- RFP process similar to LFUCG Workforce Grant Program and ESR Program
- Would allow LFUCG to target particular needs every two years



Focus Areas

- Example of areas of focus:
 - o Talent/Workforce
 - Business Retention & Expansion
 - Business Recruitment
 - Entrepreneurship/Business Start-Ups
 - Innovation Technology
 - Economic Development Marketing
 - \circ Trade



RFP AWARD PROCESS

- Process would be very similar to workforce grant program
 - Funding level determined in Lexington/Fayette Urban County Fiscal Year Budget
 - Economic Development Investment Board establish criteria, focus and targets for the next two years
 - RFP developed and sent out
 - Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government scoring committee to score applications
 - Scoring recommendations submitted to Economic Development Investment Board for discussion/approval
 - Economic Development Investment Board makes recommendations to Lexington/Fayette Urban County Council
 - Lexington/Fayette Urban County Council would make final determination on funding
