This Agreement sets forth the requirements for participation in the federal equitable sharing program and the restrictions upon the use of federally forfeited cash, property, proceeds, and any interest, which are equitably shared with participating law enforcement agencies. This Agreement also requires the submission of any discrimination cases involving the Lexington Police Department, which has been submitted by the Department of Law.
