Program, including penalties thereof, which section was subsequently amended by Ordinance No.

101-90; and

WHEREAS, the Council, by Resolution No. 168-90, adopted a procedure on Requests to Establish a Residential Parking Permit Program; which Procedure was subsequently amended by Resolutions No. 450-91, 433-2006 and 489-2014; and

WHEREAS, it is now the desire of the Council to establish a Residential Parking Permit Program for the South Side of the 400 block of West Second Street between Bruce Street and Jefferson Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE

URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - A Residential Parking Permit Program be and hereby is established for the South Side of the 400 block of West Second Street between Bruce Street and Jefferson Street, twenty four

(24) hours per day, Monday through Sunday.

Section 2 - That the Clerk of the Urban County Council be and hereby is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Council Administrator, Chief of Police, Director of the Division of Revenue, Director of the Division of Traffic Engineering and the Executive Director of the Parking Authority.

Section 3 - That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
