BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY

GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That subsection 2-87(a) of the Code of Ordinance of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-87. - Membership; terms; staff.

- (a) The members of the MSP Advisory Board shall be eighteen (18) in number and shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the advice of the constituent groups represented, subject to confirmation by a majority of the Urban County Councilmembers. Sixteen (16) members shall be voting be ex-officio, non-voting members. members and two (2) shall eighteen (18) members shall be as follows: one (1) member from the Audubon Society; one (1) member shall be from the Lexington Lions Club, (1) member Bracktown one shall be from the Neighborhood Association; one (1) member shall be from the Masterson Station Park Casual Riders; one (1) member shall be a citizen representing the Div. of Parks and Recreation Equestrian Program; one (1) member shall be from the Friends of the Dog Park; one (1) member shall be the representative to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board for the urban county district in Masterson Station Park is located, unless (s)he shall be unwilling to serve, in which case the position Urban County individual from the Council district in which Masterson Park is located; one (1) member shall be from the Kentucky Station Border Collie Association; one (1) member shall be from the McConnell Association; one (1) Neighborhood member shall Lexington Youth Soccer Association; one (1) member from shall be the Masterson Station Neighborhood Association; one (1) member shall from the Masterson Equestrian Trust Foundation; one (1) member be from the Fayette County Neighborhood Council; one (1) member shall the Marehaven/Westwood Homeowners Association; one (1) international member shall be from the sports community; one (1) member shall be a representative from Town Branch Trail, Inc.; one (1) ex -officio, non-voting member shall be the Urban County Council member that represents the urban county district in which Masterson Station Park is located; and one (1) ex-officio, non-voting member shall be the director of the Div. of Parks and Recreation or his designee.
- Section 2 That subsection 2-89(b) of the Code of Ordinance of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby is amended to read as follows:
 - (b) A majority of the voting members of the MSP Advisory Board, that is nine (9) members, shall constitute a quorum for transaction of business at any meeting of the MSP Advisory Board. The acts of a majority of those members present at any regular meeting or special meeting shall be the acts of the MSP Advisory Board, provided that it shall take a vote of nine (9) members to adopt or amend its bylaws.
